Regulations of the Health Services Policy Implementation and Research Center of Marmara University Official Gazette: January 15, 1996 / 22524

I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

Establishment

Article 1: The "Health Services Policy Implementation and Research Center" has been established under the Rectorate of Marmara University.

Purpose

Article 2: The purpose of the Center is to analyze existing systems and policies regarding the organization, provision, financing, and management of health services, collect data, and develop proposals and health service policies aimed at solving health problems in Eurasia, primarily in Turkey.

Duties of the Center

Article 3:To achieve the objectives specified in Article 2, the Center undertakes the following

- a) Collect data and create a knowledge base on the health systems, socio-demographic structures, and health indicators of various countries, particularly Central Asian Republics, Caucasus, and Balkan countries.
- b) Organize scientific meetings, conferences, and seminars to facilitate national and international exchanges of views on health service systems and policies.
- c) Conduct research and provide consultancy services on health problem solutions, planning, and organization of health services at national and regional levels.
- d) Provide training opportunities for experts in the organization, provision, financing, and management of health services.
- e) Develop cooperation channels with the World Health Organization and other relevant international and national organizations.
- f) Publish materials and journals in relevant fields in both domestic and foreign languages.

II. ORGANIZATION OF THE CENTER

Center's Bodies

Article 4: The bodies of the Center are:

- a) Director
- b) Board of Management

Director

Article 5: The Director of the Center is appointed by the Rector from among the faculty members of Marmara University for a term of three years. The Director can be reappointed after the term ends. The Director may select up to two Assistant Directors from among the faculty members, subject to the Rector's approval. In the absence of the Director, one of the Assistants will act as a substitute. The Director manages the Center in accordance with the legislation and the objectives and duties specified in Articles 2 and 3.

Board of Management

Article 6: The Board of Management consists of the Director, if any, Assistant Directors, and department heads. Board members serve for a term of three years and can be reappointed. The Board convenes upon the Director's invitation and decides on matters presented by the Director. The Director chairs the Board, and decisions are made by a simple majority.

Center's Income

Article 7 : The income of the Center includes:

- a) Allocations from the budget,
- b) Donations and contributions from domestic and foreign official and private organizations,
- c) Fees from educational, teaching, and training activities,
- d) Revenues from projects, operated facilities, and services,
- e) Income from publishing activities,

f) Revolving fund revenues.

Center's Expenditures

Article 8 : The expenditures of the Center include:

- a) Administrative expenses,
- b) Expenses related to educational and training activities,
- c) Budget expenses,
- d) Royalties, consultancy, publication, award, and promotion expenses,
- e) Expenses related to projects and operated facilities,
- f) Revolving fund operational expenses,
- g) Other expenditures as decided by the Board of Management.

III. RESPONSIBLE AUTHORITY

Article 9 : The responsible authority of the Center is the Rector. The Rector may delegate this responsibility.

IV. EFFECTIVENESS AND EXECUTION

Article 10 :These Regulations come into effect on the date of publication.

Article 11 : The provisions of these Regulations are executed by the Rector of Marmara University.
